Export Administration Regulations

Statement Issue Date: 31st August 2017

The Export Administration Regulations (EAR) is a set of United States government regulations on the export and import of most commercial items.

An ECCN is an alpha-numeric classification used in the EAR under the Commodity Control List (CCL) to identify items for export control purposes.

The VAM2 (Version 2.2) database application is classified as:

Export Control Classification Number (ECCN): EAR99

Note: Items in the EAR99 category do not require a license for "list-based" controls, but may require a license based on embargoes, sanctions, receiving party or end use.
